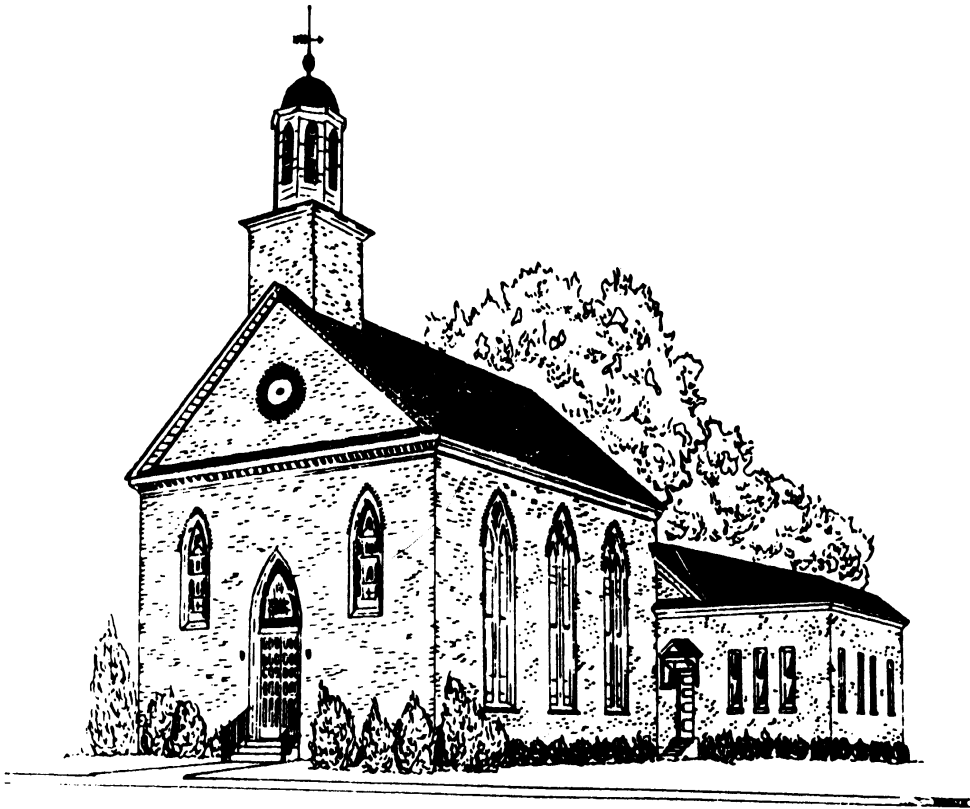

The Nicene Creed, A.D. 325
